

Turandot Camellia



Camellia japonica 'Turandot'

- **Use:** Its cold tolerant flower buds and exceptionally heavy bloom guarantee a spectacular flower show, Turandot is a large growing, cold and heat tolerant Camellia most recognized for its abundant production of very large and gorgeous, fully double, bright rose-red flowers with abundant yellow anthers at the center. Use as a hedge or specimen.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site from hot afternoon sun, in partial shade. Best in moist, acidic, organically amended, well-drained soil.
- **Growth:** A mid-size Camellia with an upright habit of growth to about 8 to 15 feet tall and 5 to 8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for glossy green foliage.
- **Flower:** Large, 4" double peony blooms are bright red with bright yellow anthers. The fruit is not ornamentally significant. Prune only right after blooms fade.
