

In The Pink Camellia

This soft pink camellia deserves a place in high profile foundation planting or as a backdrop to outdoor living spaces in the backyard. The flowers contrast beautifully against the lustrous dark green foliage. To enjoy the flowers indoors display several cuttings in vase, or float just one in a bowl of water. Camellia japonica 'In The Pink'

- **Use:** A rare beauty, In The Pink is a vigorous winter to early spring flowering Camellia that features absolutely gorgeous, full double flowers with numerous rows of rose-pink wavy petals and an occasional splash of white on some of the inner petals. Its average texture blends into the landscape, but can be balanced by one or two finer or coarser trees or shrubs for an effective composition. A prized plant of the milder regions of the U.S. Mid to late season bloomer.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade form afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 8-12' ft. tall and wide, and 6-8 feet wide at the base forming an upside down cone.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Glossy, dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Masses of lovely shell pink flowers bloom in late winter (December-March) Prune only right after blooms fade.
