- <u>Use:</u> More like a wild rose than a camellia. This medium sized charmer rings many changes white to pale pink to blushed in dark pink along the edges. This fragrant bloomer is a dependable performer for the South. Use as an evergreen hedge for winter color in your garden. Provides excellent flowering around October.
- <u>Exposure</u>: Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any <u>well</u>
 <u>drained</u> neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn;
 needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of
 sun.
- Growth: Moderate growing to 8 to 10 ft. tall and wide and 6 to 58 wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Its dark green leaves provide a wonderful backdrop and contrast of color for the flowers.
- **Flower:** Produces an abundance of eyecatching 3-4" white flowers with crinkled petals marked with fuchsia-pink along the edges. A burst of ontrasting bright yellow stamens reach out from the center are an extraadded bonus. Prune only right after blooms fade.
