- <u>Use:</u> More like a wild rose than a camellia. This medium sized charmer rings many changes pale pink to blushed in dark pink. Provides excellent flowering around October.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 5 to 6 ft. tall and wide and 4 to 5' wide.
- Hardiness: 6-9; shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen, glossy.
- **Flower:** The flowers are white with a beautiful pinkish outline. The blooms are semi-double to double in form.
- Prune only right after blooms fade.
