Londontown Blush Camellia





Tolerates heat and humidity well!

Camellia sasanqua 'Londontown Blush'

- <u>Use:</u> 'Londontowne Blush' bears semi-double pale pink flowers in midfall. This cold hardy C. sasanqua hybrid comes from Dr. William Ackerman, the camellia breeder who earlier introduced the 'Winter" camellia series. It bears single to semi-double pale pink flowers with deeply notched petals. A 10-year old plant grows 5-6 feet tall and almost as wide. They make an amazing evergreen hedge for winter color.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any <u>well</u> <u>drained</u> neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide and 4 to 6' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen, Glossy foliage.
- **Flower:** Pale pink, single to semi-double flowers that have deeply notched petals. Flowers have yellow-orange anthers and pale yellow filaments, 8-10 petals, and measure 9 cm across x 4.5 cm deep and it flowers early in the season. Prune only right after blooms fade.
