

October Magic Pink Perplexion Camellia



Camellia sasanqua 'Magic October Pink Perplexion'

- **Use:** Named for the difficulty in describing the color. It is a semi-dwarf plant with spreading to a rounded, compact growth. The soft pink flowers remind one of *Camellia japonica* 'Pink Perfection'. Small flowers appear in great profusion in fall on this compact conical camellia. Camellias are used as fall-winter specimen shrubs, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder fall-winter months when other plants are dormant.
- **Exposure:** Morning shade preferred (prevents frost damage to flowers), but tolerates sun with ample water, evenly moist, humus-rich; high in organic matter, acidic, well-drained (porous) soils, protection from cold, drying winter winds, ample moisture, mulch layer.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-5' tall and x 4-5' wide. Upright and dense growth. Can easily be pruned after blooming to keep them shorter.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Loads of fully double, 3" wide pink flowers absolutely cover up this free-flowering Pink Perfection look-alike in fall to winter.
