

# Mikuniko Camellia



Spectacular when in flower. Tolerates heat and humidity well!



## *Camellia sasanqua* 'Mikuniko'

- **Use:** Covered in coral-pink flowers from late fall to early winter. Mikuni-Ko Camellia is an evergreen shrub with bushy, upright growth. The dark green foliage contrasts beautifully with the lovely blossoms. This salt- and drought-tolerant shrub works well as a foundation shrub, specimen, or hedge. Provides excellent flowering around October.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 5 to 6 ft. tall and wide and 4 to 5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-11; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, Glossy, green foliage.
- **Flower:** Large, coral-pink flowers that bloom from late fall to early winter
- **Prune only right after blooms fade.**
