- <u>Use:</u> Covered in coral-pink flowers from late fall to early winter.
 Mikuni-Ko Camellia is an evergreen shrub with bushy, upright
 growth. The dark green foliage contrasts beautifully with the lovely
 blossoms. This salt- and drought-tolerant shrub works well as a foundation shrub, specimen, or hedge. Provides excellent flowering
 around October.
- <u>Exposure</u>: Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any <u>well</u>
 <u>drained</u> neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn;
 needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of
 sun.
- **Growth**: Moderate growing to 5 to 6 ft. tall and wide and 4 to 5' wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-11; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen, Glossy, green folaige.
- <u>Flower</u>: Large, coral-pink flowers that bloom from late fall to early winter
- Prune only right after blooms fade.
