Tolerates heat and humidity well and great as use as a hedge in shade!



Camellia sasanqua 'Moonshadow'

- **Use:** The small leaved Sasanqua Camellias make excellent landscape or container plants and are much more tolerant of sun and soil conditions than the larger flowered Japonica Camellias. These durable evergreen shrubs cover themselves in 2-3" flowers in fall and early winter and before the flowers fade the petals fall individually to form a colorful blanket beneath the dark glossy green foliage.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade form afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 8 to 12 ft. tall and 6 to 8' wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Valued for small glossy green foliage and looks beautiful year round.
- **Flower:** Perfect form, large white flowers with each petal edged in rich pink are produced in fall. An upright to spreading easy to grow evergreen shrub with excellent vigor. Very similar to the popular 'Leslie Ann' but according to Bobby Green, its hybridizer, this one has even larger flowers. Prune only right after blooms fade.
