

# Northern Exposure Camellia



Tolerates heat and humidity well!



## *Camellia sasanqua* 'Northern Exposure'

- **Use:** With its delicate single white blooms and dark green glossy foliage, this beauty is a stand-out in colder climates. It is medium-sized with an upright habit and excellent disease resistance. We love to use them to make a hedge in shade. Blooms in fall.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade from afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 8 to 10 ft tall and 6 to 8 ft. wide. Prune immediately after flowering.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark and glossy green are a perfect foil to white flowers.
- **Flower:** The single white blooms over the glossy evergreen leaves in the late fall to early winter give 'Northern Exposure' a nice clean appearance in the landscape and garden. Clip off your favorite, fresh florals and bring them inside for centerpieces, gifts and more. Plus, they're wonderful when planted and placed by the patio, pool or porch since their sweet scent enchants year after year. Prune only right after blooms fade.
