Gorgeous flowers in the middle of winter and they make a lovely hedge!



Camellia sasanqua 'Pink Serenade'

- **Use:** One of the early blooming camellias, it is an easy care large shrub. Striking in a mass planting, this plant produces pink single blooms in large amounts from fall to early winter. Small to medium sized blooms make up for size by heavily flowering. Like most camellias, it will benefit most from a bit of shelter from the wind and hot sun, since buds and leaves are susceptible to the extreme elements.
- **Exposure:** Thrives in either full sun with good irrigation (and some work), but prefers partial sun (Morning Sun) . Must amend the soil! As they hate red clay! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Can grow 8-12' tall and 10-12' wide. Space plants 4' apart to create a hedge.
- **Hardiness: Zone** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Large 4-5" flowers put on a long-lasting show of deep pink single flowers every single year in winter.
