

White Shi Shi Camellia



Camellia sasanqua 'October Magic White Shi Shi'

- **Use:** Selected for its bushy, spreading habit similar to the well-known 'ShiShi Gashira', this low growing evergreen offers porcelain-white, formal double blooms at a time of year when fewer trees and shrubs are blooming. Camellias are used as specimens, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder winter months when other plants are dormant. The leaves of Sasanqua Camellias are much smaller and dense than the Japanese Camellias, making for a smaller more compact shrub. The Shi-Shi Camellia is a late bloomer and its form is low spreading.
- **Exposure:** Thrives in either full sun with good irrigation (and some work), but prefers partial sun (Morning Sun) . Must amend the soil! As they hate red clay! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Can grow 3-4' tall and wide. Space plants 3' apart to create a hedge.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7a-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Porcelain white double formal flowers bloom from October through January—very long bloom season!
