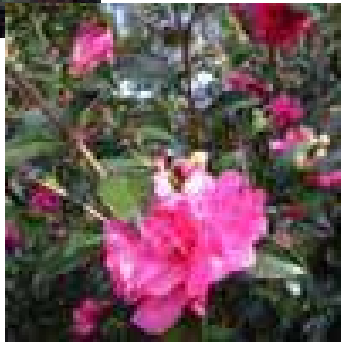


# Camellia sasanqua 'Sparkling Burgundy'

## ***Camellia sasanqua 'Sparkling Burgundy'***

- **Use:** Camellias are used as specimen large shrubs, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder winter months when other plants are dormant.
- **Exposure:** Partial shade's preferred, but tolerates sun with ample water, evenly moist, humus-rich; high in organic matter, acidic, well-drained (porous) soils, protection from cold, drying winter winds, ample moisture, mulch layer.
- **Growth:** Grows 10' tall or more tall x 3' wide or more slowly. Large upright and dense growth. Can easily be pruned after blooming to keep them shorter.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Flowers are a clear medium pink, 3.5" diameter in great profusion over a long period in the winter.
