Camellia x 'Buttermint'

- <u>Use:</u> Beautiful, pale, buttery yellow, semi-double blooms adorn this mid-to late season bloomer. Its glossy, dark green leaves and lightly fragrant, ruffled flowers are plentiful enough to cut and bring indoors. This showy evergreen is perfect for brightening up a shady woodland garden. Camellias are the rose of winter in southern gardens, with their colorful blossoms held against deep rich green glossy foliage on a naturally upright to rounded evergreen shrub. This lovely C. kissii hybrid from Nuccio's Nurseries was introduced in 1996.
- **<u>Exposure</u>**: Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- *Growth:* Quickly reaches 6 ft. tall, 4 ft. wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 7b-9 Shrub
- *Foliage:* Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.

• <u>Flower</u>: Creamy white shading to pale yellow at center. Formal double to peony, miniature (under 2.5") Mid to late spring (Mar-Apr). <u>Prune only right after blooms fade.</u>
