

Koto No Kaori Camellia



Camellias are used as specimens, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder winter months when other plants are dormant.



Camellia x 'Koto-no-kaori'

- **Use:** Koto-no-kaori (Fragrance of Ancient City) has small rose-pink cup shaped flowers and a sweet fragrance. The small single blooms are some of the most colorful of the fragrant camellias. The upright lacy growth has a hint of red on the new leaves.
- **Exposure:** Thrives in either full sun with good irrigation (and some work), but prefers partial sun (Morning Sun) . Must amend the soil! As they hate red clay! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Can grow 6-8' tall and wide. Space plants 5-6' apart to create a hedge.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Sweetly scented, single 2 inch rose pink flowers begin to appear in late fall on this charming hybrid camellia, and bloom continues throughout the winter.
