Emerald Crest Bluemist Shrub



Careopteris x clandonensis 'Emerald Crest'

- <u>Use:</u> Dense clusters of blue flowers in late Summer and Fall attract pollinators. Compact plant with glossy green leaves and a nice, mounded habit makes an excellent addition to the landscape.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Avoid heavy wet clay soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- *Growth:* Grows 2-3' tall and 24-20" wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 6a-9; Perennial/ Shrub
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Low arching habit and glossy emerald foliage are a perfect complement in the perennial border.
- *Flower:* Dense clusters of blue flowers attract pollinators from late summer until fall frost. A great butterfly, bee, hummingbird, and other pollinator insect attractor.
