

Double Take Eternal White Flowering Quince



Chaenomeles speciosa 'Double Take Eternal White'

NO THORNS! Quince is more than an early-spring delight. It stays semi-evergreen all summer and fall, and autumn. We love them as cut flowers to bring indoors the joy of spring!

- **Use:** A new, continuously flowering, thornless quince with big, double white flowers that provide visual impact even when the plant is in full leaf. DOUBLE TAKE ETERNAL WHITE™ quince is the longest-blooming flowering quince on the market. Its large doubled blooms appear in spring, and the show continues for months, often into early autumn. The delicious, camellia-like flowers open lime and then transition to pure white and the dark green foliage adds the perfect contrast. This quince is a lower, wider growing shrub than the other Double Take varieties, making it useful in many landscape areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to light shade. Flowering is best in full sun. Tolerant of most soils including very dry soils.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing 2 to 4 feet tall by 4 to 5 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Small green leaves.
- **Flower:** Plentiful creamy white blooms AND all of the buds that keep it flowering from mid-spring 'til early-summer. Many weeks longer than its fellow quince!
