- **Use:** This Cypress stands out as a versatile and highly decorative tree with its feathery scale-like leaves. These slow growing trees are typically used in outdoor garden landscaping as a specimen tree, hedging or screening plant due to its attractive and compact form. However, it also makes a great indoor potted plant for your living decor.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun and could tolerate a fair amount of shade; Prefers well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Please amend your soil if you have red clay. *If kept indoors care will be needed to give enough humidity and while they can live a short time indoors they are happiest outdoors.*
- **Growth:** Grows to 6 inches per year up to 4 feet and 3 feet wide after 10 years. Dense, pyramidal form ideal for focal points or containers
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Shrub Prefers protection from summer heat in zone 8
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Soft, prickly, silvery-blue, needle-like leaves.
- **Flowers:** Not known for flowers.
