## ***Chamaecyparis obtusa* 'Confucius'**

- **Use:** 'Confucius' hinoki cypress is like a living sculpture for the landscape. Bright lemon-yellow foliage and distinctive fan-like foliage give it instant appeal. Faster growing than 'Aurea Nana'. The effect is striking and unusual for a Hinoki cultivar. Use this textural accent where the crinkly, congested foliage will stand out. Requires excellent drainage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun and could tolerate a fair amount of shade with good air circulation. Prefers well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Please amend your soil if you have red clay.
- **Growth:** Forms a uniquely irregular pyramid 8 to 10 feet tall and 5 to 6 feet wide at the base in 10 years. Grows 6"-1' a year.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-8b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. It is clothed in feathery fans of soft foliage ranging in shades of bright lemon yellow on the outer foliage that is exposed to direct sun to soft yellow and rich green in the shadowed spaces. The golden color remains during winter taking on an attractive bronzy-orange cast.
- **Flowers:** Not known for flowers.
