
Compact Golden Hinoki Cypress



Its relatively fine texture sets it apart from other landscape plants with less refined foliage.

Chamaecyparis obtuse 'Nana Lutea'

- <u>Use:</u> This dwarf evergreen conifer feaures golden yellow fan-like foliage and an irregularly globe-shaped, upright habit. Excellent for use in rock gardens, beds or borders to bring a unique look to the landscape.
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3in of soil is dry, somewhat drought tolerant when established.
- <u>Growth</u>: Very slow grower; 18 to 36 in. tall and 36 in. wide. May grow taller over time.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-9; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen Attractive yellow foliage which emerges gold in spring. The scale-like leaves are highly ornamental and turn chartreuse in fall.
- <u>Flowers</u>: Neither the flowers nor the fruit are ornamentally significant.
