Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Cedar Rapids'

- <u>Use:</u> Where big impact meets ethereal aesthetics. Cedar Rapids false cypress grows to a useful screening height for folks living in two-story homes, but it keeps its lovely feathery texture no matter the size. Each fan of evergreen foliage is a cheerful lime green color and twists a bit, all combining to give the plant a unique texture. Its pyramidal habit makes a handsome specimen and looks commanding when grouped in a line for a hedge or screen.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun and could tolerate a fair amount of shade; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Tolerates brief dry spells. Heat and cold tolerant without the psolitting and disease issues of Leyland Cypress.
- <u>Growth:</u> Grows 30' tall and 12-15' wide. Fast growing and more disease tolerant than Leyland Cypress. Little to no trimming is required.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-8; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen The unique lime green feathery textured foliage is full and lush.
- Flowers: Not known for flowers.
