

Sixteen Candles Summersweet



Plant Natives

Clethra alnifolia 'Sixteen Candles'

- **Use:** A profusion of upright fragrant white flower spikes attract butterflies. Dense, compact habit makes it good for small gardens. Effective in mass, mixed into perennial borders or along foundations. Grows well in wet areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** This shrub can grow in sunny locations as well as shady locations but will perform best in locations with partial shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will tolerate wet soil.
- **Growth:** Slow-growing, compact habit 3 ft. tall, 4 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; The dark green foliage turns yellow in autumn.
- **Flower:** Fragrant mid-summer flowers attract butterflies and hummingbirds.
