- <u>Use</u>: A reliable groundcover with style. An easy solution to covering large areas of bare ground quickly, inexpensively, and, most important, beautifully. This sprawling shrub is a galaxy of tiny white, five-petaled flowers in spring, which give way to cheery red fruits through summer. Finely textured foliage makes it a restful visual presence in the landscape. It's also a good choice for cascading over retaining walls and high bed edges.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: Fast-growing to 6-12" tall high, to 5-6 ft. wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-8 Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Shiny, delicate green foliage. Purple tinge to fall foliage enhances profusion of coral-red berries.
- *Flower:* White flowers in spring, red fruit in summer and fall.
