## Hesperocyparis (Cupressus) macrocarpa 'Goldcrest'

- <u>Use</u>: Prized for it's foliage it is an excellent container plant (for a few years) or color accent for your garden. More exciting than another plain hedge of Leyland Cypress in the neighborhood......
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Once established needs only occasional water.
- <u>Growth:</u> Expect them to get about 6-10' tall in 10 years. Estimated height in 50 year about 40 ft tall and 12-20 ft wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 7-9 Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen. Chartreuse foliage with a green tint. When crushed foliage smells of lemon.
- Flower: Not know for flowers.
