

# Goldcrest Monterey Cypress



## *Hesperocyparis (Cupressus) macrocarpa* 'Goldcrest'

- **Use:** Prized for its foliage it is an excellent container plant (for a few years) or color accent for your garden. More exciting than another plain hedge of Leyland Cypress in the neighborhood.....
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Expect them to get about 6-10' tall in 10 years. Estimated height in 50 year about 40 ft tall and 12-20 ft wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Chartreuse foliage with a green tint. When crushed foliage smells of lemon.
- **Flower:** Not know for flowers.
