

Goldcrest Lemon Cypress Topiary



Bring the elegance of the Mediterranean to your garden!

Cupressus (Hesperocyparis) macrocarpa 'Goldcrest'

- **Use:** Prized for its foliage it is an excellent container plant (for a few years-then plant outside) or color accent for your garden. More exciting than just another juniper the texture is lovely in winter on porch steps, a table, or patio...
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Best would be 6-8 hours early day sun with a little afternoon shade to protect them from our hot summers. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Expect them to get about 6-10' tall in 10 years. However, for a few years you can keep them lightly trimmed and enjoy them in pots. Estimated height in 50 year about 40 ft tall and 12-20 ft wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9 Shrub Not happy inside the home so keep outdoors where they can enjoy cool nights.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Chartreuse foliage with a green tint. When crushed foliage smells of lemon.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
