

# Sister Disco® Scotch Broom



This upright Scotch broom has a distinctive broom-like silhouette that makes it a striking textural accent in garden beds and landscaping planting.



## *Cytisus scoparius* 'SMNCSCRY' PP30186

- **Use: Can you dig it?** Sister Disco® Scotch broom is a far-out burst of color for your spring garden. Each pea-shaped bloom is screaming yellow dabbled with bright red. This spring bloomer is especially when paired with colorful spring blooming bulbs like daffodils, tulips, and crocus. Sister Disco Scotch broom loves sunny, dry conditions, which the bulbs also like, so pairing these plants together works visually as well as horticulturally! After blooming, wiry green stems are covered in tiny leaves, which provide a unique textural effect.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs full sun and well-drained soil. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Puddling water is a sure death sentence. Would perform well on a dry slope in full sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing 2-3' foot tall and 1-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a– 8b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Wiry green stems are covered in tiny leaves, which provide a unique textural effect.
- **Flower:** Vibrant yellow and red flowers in spring. Great as a cut flower too, offering a rustic, airy texture to arrangements.
