

Eternal Fragrance Daphne



**Sweet fragrant shrub
for your shade garden!**



Daphne x transatlantica 'BLAFRA' PP #18,361

- **Use:** A profusion of blush pink flower clusters adorns this compact form over many months providing long-lasting beauty and fragrance in the garden. A tidy landscape shrub for group plantings and small urban gardens. Remains evergreen in temperatures above 0° Fahrenheit; deciduous elsewhere. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** WHILE WE LOVE DAPHNE IT IS NOT A PLANT FOR BEGINNERS. THEY MUST HAVE GOOD SOIL AND EXCELLENT DRAINAGE. MORNING SUN/AFTERNOON SHADE IS ALSO A MUST IN GA. Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Feed with a general purpose fertilizer before new growth begins in spring. Soil must be amended with a rich organic matter or peat based soil. Will not tolerate red clay. For a tidy, neat appearance, shear annually to shape. Prune after blooms have faded. Be gentle with rootball when transplanting.
- **Growth:** Slow growing; reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Green foliage
- **Flower:** Flowers are white with an orange-yellow eye and they turn to pink-purple hues in cool nights. Heaviest in spring; repeating lightly from summer to fall.
