
Chardonnay Pearls Deutzia

Deutzia 'Chardonnay Pearls'

- <u>Use:</u> Season-long color! Like other deutzia, Chardonnay Pearls® graces springtime with abundant pearl-like buds that burst into attractive star-shaped flowers. Once the flowers have faded, however, Chardonnay Pearls® deutzia remains compelling with with bright yellow foliage through frost. Growth is strong but compact, creating a versatile small shrub that is equally at home in the shrub border or the perennial garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Feed with a general purpose fertilizer before new growth begins in spring. Soil must be amended with a rich organic matter or peat based soil. Will not tolerate red clay. For a tidy, neat appearance, shear annually to shape.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 20-36" tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-8b, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Its elliptical leaves are charteuse green, held opposite to one another on the stem and rich purple-burgundy fall foliage.
- Flower: Fragrant white spring flowers. Season long color.
