

Swing Low Distylium



Distylium 'Swing Low'

- **Use:** A low growing evergreen, this plant makes a perfect groundcover, adaptable for a variety of landscape applications. Dense, blue-green leaves arranged on horizontal branching respond well to pruning and are disease and insect resistant. Deer resistant although deer may take a few tastes before they figure it out.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows in full to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Very adaptable plant that responds well to pruning and grows well in dry soil, wet soil, seasonally flooded areas, and even slopes.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and 4-6' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Bears refined blue-green leaves on horizontal branches.
- **Flower:** Very small reddish maroon flowers appear in late winter, which also gives this plant some nice seasonal interest too.



Will tolerate wet sites and is also drought tolerant and is perfect shrub for the front of the bed or as a fountain shrub.
