

# Distylium Cinnamon Girl



## *Distylium 'Cinnamon Girl'*

**Will tolerate wet sites and is also drought tolerant and is perfect shrub for the front of the bed.**



- **Use:** Consider this new small leaf selection an alternative to boxwood and other evergreen plants beleaguered by insects and diseases in the south. The small leaves and compact growth give this plant a more refined look than other Distylium on the market. It came through the 2014-15 winter without winter burn while other varieties had moderate to severe dieback. Definitely the most cold hardy Distylium to date.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows in full to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will tolerate wet soil.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and 4-5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Has plum-purple new growth which turns blue-green as the leaves mature
- **Flower:** Very small reddish maroon flowers appear in late winter, which also gives this plant some nice seasonal interest too.
