

# Little Champ Distylium



Will tolerate wet sites and is also drought tolerant and is perfect shrub for the front of the bed or as a fountain shrub.



## *Distylium x 'DISmd-26-18' PPAFF*

- **Use:** A low growing evergreen, this plant makes a perfect groundcover, adaptable for a variety of landscape applications. Dense, dark green leaves arranged on horizontal branching respond well to pruning and are disease and insect resistant. Deer resistant although deer may take a few tastes before they figure it out.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grows in full to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Very adaptable plant that responds well to pruning and grows well in dry soil, wet soil, seasonally flooded areas, and even slopes.
- **Growth:** Grows 1-2' tall and 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Rich dark green glossy leaves
- **Flower:** Very small reddish maroon flowers appear in late winter, which also gives this plant some nice seasonal interest too.
