

Fire Ball Seedless® Burning Bush



Euonymus alatus 'NCEA1' PPAF

- **Use:** *The only seedless, non-invasive burning bush on the market!* Enjoy all the glory of a burning bush without any worry about invasiveness. Fire Ball Seedless™ euonymus is crimson in fall and seedless all year long. Its mature size is very manageable, and like its contemporary fellows, it responds well to a trim. It is best used as a specimen or hedge. Combine this versatile shrub with other winter bloomer such as Camellias, and Forsythia.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Tolerates close to full shade, but usually at the expense of diminished fall color quality. This is an adaptable shrub that tolerates a wide range of soils except for wet, poorly-drained ones. Plants appreciate consistent moisture, particularly when grown in full sun locations.
- **Growth:** Can grow 5-7' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Elliptic to obovate, crenulate to serrulate, green leaves (to 3" long) turn bright red in fall. **Fall color can be spectacular.**
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers. Sterile.
