

# Double Mint Gardenia



## *Gardenia jasminoides* 'Double Mint'

- **Use:** Reblooms, reblooms, reblooms! From midsummer through early fall, this compact, robust little shrub sets masses of double-flowered white blooms, wondrously fragrant and so beautiful among glossy evergreen foliage. Add it to your landscape at once! This quick-growing shrub begins blooming the very first season, and continues for many years thereafter. You're going to love it in the border, meadow garden, or your finest containers!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun! (May tolerate full sun, but then must have irrigation or good watering schedule!) Prefers well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. RED CLAY MUST BE AMENDED! Water regularly, but does not like wet feet.
- **Growth:** Very tightly branched and dense, remaining just 2½ to 3 feet high and wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Glossy green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Setting big 2-inch flowers of softest ivory-white. The fragrance these blooms release is sweet, pervasive, and simply heavenly.

There's nothing like a 'Double Mint' shrub beneath a window or along a garden path!!
