Gardenia jasminoides 'Radicans Variegata'

- **Use:** Excellent in low borders or as a ground cover. Great container plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun (only with good irrigation)/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly when top 3in of soil is dry. Must amend the soil if you have red clay! We recommend our **Pro Mix Soil!**
- **Growth:** Moderate, spreading grower to 6 to 12 inches tall, 2 to 3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Glossy green and white leaves, evergreen.
- **Flowers:** Same great fragrance as larger gardenias, but having a dwarf, rounded form enhanced with petite white flowers
