## *Gardenia jasminoides* 'Scentamazing'

- **Use:** A charming improvement on a Southern favorite, grows compactly and blooms heavily in spring; reblooming fragrantly through summer into fall. Great in containers, raised beds and in the background of borders. Lustrous foliage on a rounded evergreen shrub, useful as a hedge, screen or accent for entryways. It has a tight, upright form so it fits into any garden and is great for containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun! (May tolerate full sun, but then must have irrigation or good watering schedule!) Prefers well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. RED CLAY MUST BE AMENDED! Water regularly, but does not like wet feet.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3-4 feet tall, and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Glossy green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Fragrant white blooms begin in late spring, reblooming summer through fall.

**Create a stir in your garden with re-blooming tiny, fragrant single white blossoms spring to fall. Enjoy intoxicating early blooms against dark evergreen foliage.**
