- <u>Use:</u> An exceptionally cold hardy and free flowering Gardenia, Snow Girl produces a big show of fragrant single flowers in early summer and continues to produce some flowers into late summer. This little beauty has deep green dainty foliage and a tight compact habit to help get her through the toughest of winters. Small enough to enjoy in containers or let this little gal perfume the summer garden and landscape.
- Exposure/Soil: Prefers part sun! (May tolerate full sun, but then
 must have irrigation or good watering schedule!) Prefers welldraining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. RED CLAY
 MUST BE AMENDED! Water regularly, but does not like wet feet.
- **Growth**: Moderate grower to 20-24" tall, and 36" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 7-10; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen; Dark green foliage.
- <u>Flowers</u>: Fragrant, large, single white blooms begin in late spring, reblooming summer through fall.
