

# Swan Princess Gardenia



Gardenias are a classic choice for both formal and cottage gardens, combining the structure of a bold, evergreen shrub with richly fragrant, exquisite white blooms.

## ***Gardenia jasminoides '4KIMYMJ01' PP29857***

- **Use:** A petite evergreen shrub that exudes grace and beauty, this early-blooming dwarf gardenia produces a profusion of fragrant, velvety white, double blooms with bright yellow centers that embellish the glossy dark green foliage in spring. A real asset for a raised bed, or border front. Plant near an entry or outdoor seating to best enjoy the fragrance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun! (May tolerate full sun, but then must have irrigation or good watering schedule!) Prefers well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. RED CLAY MUST BE AMENDED! Water regularly, but does not like wet feet.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 2 1/2 ft. tall, 3 ft. wide; may grow larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Glossy green leaves.
- **Flowers:** A true delight in a petite package, with fragrant, double flowers starting early in the season and a generous rebloom.
