Gardenia jasminoides 'Sweet Tea'

- **Use:** This new reblooming double gardenia has tennis ball size flowers with the gardenia fragrance we all know and love. Sweet Tea™ is more upright and larger than Double Mint and is more winter hardy.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun! (May tolerate full sun, but then must have irrigation or good watering schedule!) Prefers well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. RED CLAY MUST BE AMENDED! Water regularly, but does not like wet feet.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-5' tall and wide and would make a good low hedge.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Glossy green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Setting big 2-inch flowers of softest ivory-white. The fragrance these blooms release is sweet, pervasive, and simply heavenly.
