
White Chiffon Rose of Sharon







This is a nice addition to the mixed border, and can also be used as a specimen plant for late summer interest. Excellent for hedging.





Hibiscus (Althea) syriacus 'Chiffon White



- <u>Use:</u> The Chiffon® series just got more exciting with the addition of this white-flowered selection. It has the same vigorous growth and lacy blooms, but with large, single white flowers. Each is adorned with a lacy center to create an anemone -like bloom. Bold yet delicate, it is a star in the garden from late summer to fall. The distinctive flower color complements many popular late summer perennials.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Grow in full sun in ordinary soil. To increase bloom and to shape, prune to 2 buds per branch when dormant. Prefers to be watered under the leaves.
- *Growth:* Grows 9-12' tall and 6-8' wide.
- *Hardiness:* 5-9 Shrub/ Small Tree. Very heat tolerant!
- *Foliage:* Deciduous; Medium green maple-like leaves.
- <u>Flower</u>: Unusual white flowers for the late summer garden.
