
White Pearl Rose of Sharon









Hibiscus (Althea) syriacus 'White Pearl'

- <u>Use:</u> Mid-late season color for hedges, perennial or shrub borders, specimen and containers. This is a nice addition to the mixed border, and can also be used as a specimen plant for late summer interest. Excellent for hedging.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Grow in full sun in ordinary soil. To increase bloom and to shape, prune to 2 buds per branch when dormant. Prefers to be watered under the leaves.
- **Growth:** Growing 10 to 12 feet tall and about 6 to 7 feet wide, it can be grown as a shrub or small tree.
- *Hardiness*: 5-9 Shrub/ Small Tree. Very heat tolerant!
- *Foliage:* Deciduous; Medium green maple-like leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Unusual white flowers for the mid-late summer garden.
