- Exposure/Soil: Plant in a mainly sunny (but give them a break from 2-5pm sun is best in the South) They can tolerate full sun up North, but here in the South will see leaf burn in late summer if given all day sun. Prefers well-drained soil, but keep moderately watered. Prune in late winter or early spring. Soil pH does not affect flower color.
- Growth: Fast-growing to 3-4 feet high; and 4-5' wide in only 3 –4 years.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 3-9 Shrub
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Coarsely toothed, glossy, dark-green leaves.
- **Flower:** Massive flowers bloom in summer, and are held up by very sturdy stems. Flowers open green, then mature to white before turning green at the end of their life cycle. Good for cut flowers. This cultivar boasts 2-3 times more flowers than any other Hydrangea arborescens.
