Hydrangea arborescens 'Invincibelle Ruby'

- **Use:** The dark burgundy red flower buds of Invincibelle Ruby open to a two-toned combination of bright ruby red and silvery pink. The foliage is extra dark and stems are strong, making this new hydrangea a gem in any garden. It is a strong rebloomer that will be an excellent addition to any garden. Like other smooth hydrangeas, it flowers on new growth and so blooms every year without fail.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in a part-sun, well-drained spot; some early afternoon shade is beneficial in hot southern regions. Prune in late winter or early spring. Soil pH does not affect flower color.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-4' tall and 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The deep, dark green foliage backs these summer gems beautifully
- **Flower:** The flower clusters appear on new wood, first as dark burgundy-red buds, then erupt in a dazzling display of two-toned, bright ruby red and silvery pink flowers.
