

Big Daddy Hydrangea



A must have for every garden!

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Big Daddy'

- **Use:** Giant flower heads -- a foot across or more -- from early summer to fall. Plants grow into sturdily branched, rounded shrubs with the dark green, glossy leaves characteristic of the species. Thriving in heat and humidity, 'Big Daddy' is fast growing and easy to care for. Use this fantastic plant in your landscape as a specimen, a container plant, near water gardens or ponds, or in mass plantings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in light shade. In full sun foliage will burn in late summer. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. Pink in alkaline (limey) soils and blue in acidic soils.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 5-6 feet high; equal width quickly.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large leaves offer a lush backdrop to the showy blossoms.
- **Flower:** The 12 – 14 inch flower heads on this new introduction radiates blue and pink in tightly-clustered masses of gigantic blooms. Can bloom for more than six months in warm areas, especially if deadheaded regularly, and the flower heads—blue on acid soils, pink on alkaline—are up to 9in across.
