Hydrangea macrophylla Caipirinha

- <u>Use</u>: A stunning variety of hydrangea known for its captivating beauty and versatility. These plants are simply a delight. Caipirinha's flowers start the season a creamy yellow, almost pale green the creamy yellow fades to white, with a hint of green, and as the season progresses into autumn the flowers become edged red.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Partial sun is best or at least protection from hot afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN! As this hydrangea blooms only on wood winter protection recommended when temps go below 25 degrees to protect the buds in winter.
- Growth: Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- for eve- Hardiness: Zone 4-9; Shrub
 - Foliage: Deciduous. Large heart shaped leaves. The fall color of the foliage is burgundy when the cool weather comes on long and slow.
 - **Flower:** Features blooms that change color from green to white to green again. Blooms on old wood.
