Hydrangea macrophylla Caipirinha

- **Use:** A stunning variety of hydrangea known for its captivating beauty and versatility. These plants are simply a delight. Caipirinha's flowers start the season a creamy yellow, almost pale green the creamy yellow fades to white, with a hint of green, and as the season progresses into autumn the flowers become edged red.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun is best or at least protection from hot afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!** As this hydrangea blooms only on wood winter protection recommended when temps go below 25 degrees to protect the buds in winter.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large heart shaped leaves. The fall color of the foliage is burgundy when the cool weather comes on long and slow.
- **Flower:** Features blooms that change color from green to white to green again. Blooms on old wood.
