

# Cityline Paris Hydrangea



Excellent colorful addition to perennial or shrub borders, as a hedge, in mixed containers, or as a cut flower.

## *Hydrangea macrophylla* 'Cityline'

- **Use:** Ooh la la! The tight, compact habit of Cityline Paris hydrangea makes it a well-behaved garden or landscape plant, while its vivid deep red flowers make a bold and stylish statement. One of the smallest hydrangeas on the market, it does not need pruning (in fact, don't prune it at all!) and its deep green mildew-resistant foliage looks handsome all season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers morning sun, afternoon shade, and a moist, well-drained soil. Avoid planting it on hot, dry, exposed sites. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN IN THE SOUTH! Keeps its red color in most any soil, developing only purplish centers in acidic soils.**
- **Growth:** Reaches 1 to 3 ft. tall and wide in only 3 –4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome foliage on boldly branched, mounded form.
- **Flower:** Intense pink-red summer flowers are long lasting, maturing to an attractive green with age. The reddest flower color of any big-leaf hydrangea
