- Growth: Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large heart shaped leaves. The fall color of the foliage is burgundy when the cool weather comes on long and slow.
- <u>Flower:</u> The blooms emerge lime green and mature to a refreshing bright white a thirst-quenching contrast. It is extremely bud hardy, so it will reliably bloom on both old and new wood. Reblooming type.
