

Heart Throb Hydrangea



Excellent colorful addition to perennial or shrub borders, as a hedge, in mixed containers, or as a cut flower.

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Heart Throb'

- **Use:** A magnificent variety, certain to grab your attention. Dark red blooms edged with green, age to green with hints of red for a memorable look over 3 seasons. A compact grower for a small garden space.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers morning sun, afternoon shade, and a moist, well-drained soil. Avoid planting it on hot, dry, exposed sites. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN IN THE SOUTH! Keeps its red color in most alkaline soil, developing purplish hints in acidic soils.**
- **Growth:** Reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall and wide in only 3 –4 years.
- **Hardiness: Zone** 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome dense, rich-green foliage on boldly branched, mounded form.
- **Flower:** Abundant clusters of dark cherry red blooms tipped with green that mature to a rich, antiqued red for outstanding fall color. Blooming on both new and old wood means repeat flowers all season long, even beyond frost, and the flowers are excellent for cutting!
