

Mini Penny Hydrangea



A must have for every garden!

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Mini Penny'

- **Use:** Large mophead flowers appear nearly continuously on this exceptional dwarf, compact shrub. Blossoms tend to be blue when planted in acidic soils, and pink in more alkaline soils. A wonderful container plant, low flowering hedge or highlight of a flowering border. Highly disease resistant foliage. Use this fantastic plant in your landscape as a specimen, a container plant, near water gardens or ponds, or in mass plantings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in light shade. In full sun foliage will burn in late summer. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. Pink in alkaline (limey) soils and blue in acidic soils.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 2-3 feet high and 3-4' wide
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large leaves offer a lush backdrop to the showy blossoms.
- **Flower:** This re-blooming mophead features inflorescences ranging 4-6 inches wide. Their color will be pink or blue depending on aluminum availability in soil.
